

ROTOR



In the resting position the nails stay firmly in their slots, sunk in rubber. Rubber is the only element that touches the floor. Nails can be easily removed from resting position with your bare hands; if the sole is dirty you can simply use a pen, a key, or a hook which can be supplied separately.



In the working position the nails come out of the heel to grip on the snow or ice. If you don't want to bring the nails back to their original position immediately, they can be left in the working position even on pavement or other hard floors.
